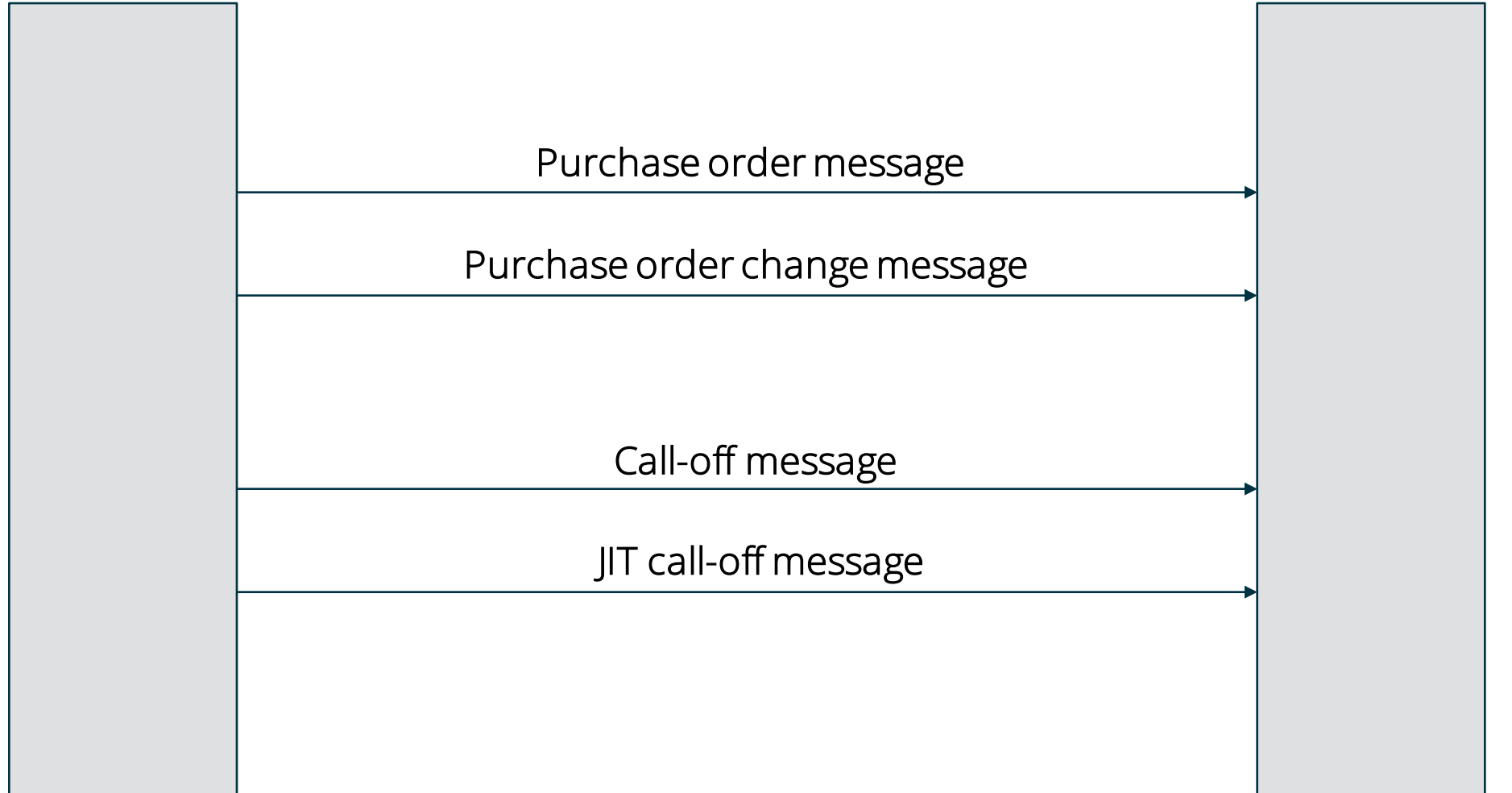

Background

- Fuba Automotive is no longer part of Delphi Automotive.
- On 29.06.2016 23:59 CEST all EDI connections will be switched from Delphi Automotive to ecosio, the EDI service provider of Fuba Automotive.
- The WebEDI portal of Covisint will no longer be used by Fuba. Instead the WebEDI portal of ecosio will be used.
- In dedicated Webinar trainings, WebEDI users may inform themselves about the features and requirements of the new ecosio WebEDI.

Transition phase from Delphi to Fuba

Receiving documents

- You will receive forecasts and spot orders in the old system until July 6, 2016
- The first forecasts and spot orders from Fuba's new system will arrive in the WebEDI system on July 7, 2016 in the morning

Sending documents

- Stop sending dispatch advice documents in the old WebEDI system on June 29, 2016, 23:59 CEST
- Start sending dispatch advice documents in the new WebEDI system on June 30, 2016, 00:00 CEST

What's next?

Access credentials

- Your access credentials will be sent to you in week 26
- You may expect the first forecasts and orders in week 27

Notification mechanism

- You may provide an email address of your choice. Upon receipt of a new forecast or a new orders message you will be notified by email.
